ORDER

Appellant's motion for sanctions is denied.

Appellant's request to amend his motion for leave to file a Rule 60(b), SCRCR, motion for a new trial with the lower court is denied. Appellant's request to strike Respondent's motion to allow late filing of its return to Appellant's motion for leave to file a Rule 60(b), SCRCR, motion is denied. Appellant's motion for leave to file a Rule 60(b), SCRCR, motion is also denied.

Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is denied.

Appellant's motion to allow late filing of his initial brief and designation of matter is granted. However, the brief and designation filed simultaneously with Appellant's motion to allow late filing fail to comply with Rules 208(b)(1) and 209 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file an initial brief and designation of matter that comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules or this appeal will be dismissed. *See* Rule 208(b)(1), SCACR (providing the required content for the appellant's initial brief); Rule 209, SCACR (providing the requirements for the parties' designation of matter).
