Dear Ms. Kitchings and Ms. Howard:

I am the Special Administrator of the Estate of Gloria P. Corley, and was made a party to this action both in that capacity and individually.

On March 22, 2024 Ballard filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari after denial of rehearing by the Court of Appeals. Both Adam Silvernail, counsel for the Estate, and I, individually, need access to the Record on Appeal (ROA) to have adequate time to consider and prepare our responses to the Petition for Certiorari.

The ROA was filed on or about March 26, 2020. As I recall someone in the Clerk's office advised Mr. Silvernail years ago that there was an issue with the failure of Petitioners to redact a check. I was not part of the conversation.
