ORDER

On December 27, 2023, Appellant filed a notice of appeal concerning two circuit court orders. On January 2, 2024, this court advised Appellant of deficiencies with his filing. On January 17, 2024, Appellant cured one of the deficiencies and requested additional time to cure the other deficiency. This court granted Appellant's request and required the deficiency to be cured by January 26, 2024. On February 7, 2024, this court dismissed the appeal because Appellant had not cured the deficiency. Appellant filed a motion to reinstate on February 22, 2024, and he provided the necessary filing fee for the notice of appeal. No return to the motion to reinstate was filed. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to reinstate. Within ten days of this order, Appellant must file a copy of the letter showing he timely ordered the transcript from the court reporter. If he has not timely ordered the transcript, Appellant must serve and file a motion requesting permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadlines along with a copy of his letter addressed to the court reporter. Failure to comply with this order will result in dismissal.
