

ORDER

Appellant filed its initial brief and designation of matter on January 22, 2024. Respondents moved to strike items 10 and 11 from Appellant's designation of matter and to strike portions of the initial brief that refer to items 10 and 11. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion to strike. Respondents moved to allow late filing of a reply to the return, which was not opposed by Appellant. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to allow late filing of the reply to the return. The reply to the return is accepted as filed.

After careful consideration of the filings, we grant the motion to strike. *See* Rule 209(b), SCACR ("A party shall not include any matter in his [d]esignation which is not relevant to the appeal."); Rule 210(c), SCACR (explaining the record on appeal . . . must not "include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal"). Within thirty days of the date of this order, Appellant must serve and file an amended initial brief and designation of matter that complies with this order and the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
