

ORDER

On August 15, 2023, Appellant filed an amended designation of matter. On February 12, 2024, Respondents moved to strike items 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 from Appellant's amended designation of matter, arguing these matters were not before the circuit court when it rendered the order that is the subject of the appeal. Appellant did not file a return to the motion to strike. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to strike items 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 from Appellant's amended designation of matter. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR (explaining the record on appeal . . . must not "include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal"). Within twenty days of the date of this order, Appellant shall file and serve a second amended designation of matter omitting items 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10. Failure to comply will result in dismissal of the appeal.
