I am in receipt of the Court's letter dated March 27, 2024, citing Respondent's Final Brief for the following deficiency:

The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the cover of the respondents' final brief does not contain all counsel of record.

I am writing to clarify the nature of the deficiency so that I can address it properly. Rule 267(a), SCACR states in relevant part:

All documents filed in the appellate court shall be headed by a caption. Except as provided below for appeals from administrative tribunals, **the caption shall contain ... the name, address and phone number of the counsel submitting the document**, or in the case of a Record on Appeal or Appendix, the names, addresses and phone numbers of all counsel in the case.

The caption of Respondents' Final Brief contains the only counsel submitting the Final Brief on behalf of the Respondents. Mr. Maroney left my law firm and is not submitting any filing on behalf of the Respondents due to Respondents' termination of his representation once he left my firm. Since I am the only counsel of record submitting the document on behalf of the Respondents, I am writing to confirm the additional counsel of record that I need to ask the printer to add to caption on the covers, and I would appreciate any additional guidance that the court might provide on this point.
