**NOW COMES**, Respondents Amedisys Holding, LLC (“Amedisys”) and Leisa Victoria Neasbitt (“Neasbitt”), by and through their undersigned counsel and pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, respectfully move this Honorable Court unopposed for an Order extending Respondents’ deadline by which to file their Response to Petitioner Nicole Lampo’s (“Lampo”) opening brief. In support of their unopposed motion, Respondents state as follows:

1. On February 7, 2024, this Honorable Court granted Lampo’s petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned matter. Thereafter, on March 7, 2024, Lampo filed her opening brief. Thus, pursuant to Rule 242(i), SCACR, Respondent’s response brief is currently due on or before April 8, 2024.

2.
