ORDER

This appeal arises out of a case filed in the court of common pleas that has been removed to the federal district court. It appears Appellant is attempting to appeal from this matter. The notice of appeal is dismissed as void because the district court has not issued a certified order of remand. *See Limehouse v. Hulsey*, 404 S.C. 93, 109-10 ("Because the absence of a certified order precluded jurisdiction from resuming in the state court, we hold the state court proceedings conducted after the federal court's entry of the remand order are void.").
