


INDICTMENT

Felony Driving Under the Influence – Resulting in Death

That in Berkeley County, South Carolina, on or about June 24, 2020, the Defendant, Steve W. Jones, while driving a vehicle under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or a combination of alcohol, drugs, and/or any other substance, did an act forbidden by law or neglected a duty imposed by law in the driving of said vehicle, to wit: Failure to Obey a Traffic-Control Device and/or Traffic-Control Signal, Failure to Stop, Failure to Yield Right-of -Way, Failure to Exercise Due Care, Speeding, and/or Reckless Driving, and such act or neglect proximately caused death to Garland Denson; all in violation of Section 56-5-2945 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.


INDICTMENT


