MOTION TO REQUEST RECONSIDERATION
AND/OR
NOTICE OF APPEAL

COMES NOW, Appellant filed this Motion to Reconsider Court’s Order dated MArch 28, 2023. granting the Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss that alleged the Appellant failed to file her amended initial brief designation of matter within the time prescribed.

On February 9, 2024, this court ordered Appellant to file and serve an amended initial brief and designation of matter within ten (10) days. Appellant reasserted that she filed her amended initial brief and designation of matter within the prescribed ten (10) days. The Court noted Rule 263(a), SCACR; however, this rule states the following. “(a) In computing any period

of time prescribed or allowed by these Rules, by order of court, or by any applicable statute, the day of the act, event, or default after which the designated period of time begins to run is not to be included. The last day of the period so computed is to be included, unless it is a Saturday, Sunday or a state or federal holiday, in which event the period runs until the end of the next day which is neither a Saturday, Sunday nor such a holiday.”. This Rule clearly reflects complete calculation for filing within prescribed ten (10) days. Full calculation for filing does not include weekends and holidays, as such from February 9, 2024 to February 26, 2024, excluding weekends and holidays are exactly as prescribed within the ten (10) days as ordered by the court. February 26, 2024 up until 11:59 pm, Appellant may file her amended initial brief and designation of matter.

Also please take note that the Appellant followed the same Rule 263(a) which excludes weekend and holidays when she received a letter from the court, dated November 1, 2023 stating that she must file her initial brief and designation of matter along with motion to file out of time within

ten (10) days or her case would be dismissed. Appellant filed it on November 16, 2023


