ORDER

On February 7, 2024, this court ordered Appellant to serve and file a supplemental record on appeal within thirty days of the order. Although Appellant submitted a collection of documents on March 20, 2024, Appellant did not file a supplemental record on appeal in compliance with Rules 210 and 212 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. Respondent moved to dismiss the appeal because Appellant failed to comply with this court's order. Appellant filed a return, explaining he miscalculated the deadline for filing the supplemental record on appeal and asking this court to accept his previous filing as the supplemental record on appeal. After careful consideration, we deny Respondent's motion to dismiss and Appellant's request to accept his previous filing as the supplemental record on appeal. Appellant shall file and serve a supplemental record on appeal containing all documents designated by the parties, which were omitted from the previously filed record on appeal, that complies with Rules 210 and 212 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules within twenty days of the date of this order. Thereafter, the parties shall serve and file their amended final briefs within ten days of the date of service of the supplemental record on appeal. Failure to comply will result in the dismissal of this appeal.
