
Dear Counsel:

The Supreme Court issued an order reducing the number of copies required in appellate matters. *See Re: Reduced Number of Copies Required in Appellate Matters* (S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated August 25, 2021). As permitted by the order, the Court of Appeals has determined a need exists for 2 additional bound copies
