ORDER

Appellant moved to unseal a portion of his trial transcript that is on file with the Dorchester County Clerk of Court because Appellant would like to use the transcript in the record on appeal. Respondent opposes this request, but Respondent does not oppose Appellant's counsel obtaining a copy of the trial transcript after it is unsealed.
