Dear Ms. Kitchings, Ms. Harrison,

I have not yet received a completed transcript for the Appellate Case: 2024 - 001031 now merged with 2023 - 0001023. Ms. Holmes stated in her letter to me that she would worked with the court reporter, Julie Kevish, to address my challenge to the transcript produced by Ms. Kevish. Additionally, I had sent Ms. Kevish several questions related to the incomplete transcript. Ms. Holmes indicated that she would address those questions.

On March 18, 2024, I received an email from Ms. Holmes indicating that there were no changes to the transcript and she did not address the additional questions to Ms. Kevish regarding the abridged version of the transcript from Ms. Kevish. Ms. Holmes provided answers that are true, but she did not provide THE WHOLE TRUTH. The email from Ms. Holmes is attached below.

I realize that Ms. Kevish producing an incomplete and altered transcript might cause her to loose her position. However, I must have a complete transcript and I must have the questions answered regarding the reason an incomplete transcript was produced. None of the six points in my letter of March 6, 2024 were addressed. And, the South Carolina Rules required for the Court Reporter have not been followed.

3. **There is not a rule where the court reporter has to indicate the exact time the case**

was called and the exact time the case ended.

- 4. The calling of the case was indicated on page 2 at line 18**
- 5. The parties are identified on page 1 along with their respective attorneys**
- 6. The Plaintiff's attorneys do not have to be sworn in as they are officers of the court. The Plaintiff did not get sworn in because the Plaintiff did not speak.**
- 7. In the transcript where you see "--", that is where someone changed what they were saying, not that verbiage is missing.**

My review of the transcript you challenged stands as is with no changes. The transcript reflects what was said in court on April 24, 2023.
