MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION TO SERVE AND FILE
THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Chevis Jake Morris respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Chevis Jake Morris respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. James L. Ginther with the Supreme Court on April 2, 2024. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant, designation of matter and record on appeal in the case of The State v. Michael Roldan with the Court of Appeals on March 28, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Terry L. Sanders with the Court of Appeals on March 25, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antonio O. Simmons v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 15, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari pursuant to Austin v. State in the case of Antonio O. Simmons v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 15, 2024. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Ryan Edward Stevens with the Court of Appeals on March 8, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tara Mahan v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 27, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. James L. Ginther with the Court of Appeals on February 21, 2024. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antonio Scott v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 21, 2024. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Justin Young v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 9, 2024. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Derek Maner v. The State before the Court of Appeals on February 6, 2024.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
