
**ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR

This case came before the Court for trial April 8 through April 12, 2013. After a verdict was rendered, the Defense requested to file post-trial motions within ten (10) days. The trial judge being a visiting judge declined the request pursuant to Rules 50 and 59, *SCRCP*, and required the Defendants to go forward with all of their post-trial motions. The Court heard and denied the Defendants' oral post-trial motions. The Defendants thereafter on April 25, 2013 filed post-trial motions, including a Motion to Reconsider, Motion for Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict, and Motion to Alter or Amend the Judgment. Because the Court denied the oral motions and did not grant leave to file motions, the Court considers the filed motions as a Motion to Reconsider. The Court has considered all of the issues raised in the filed Motion for Reconsideration. The Court espoused its reasons for denying the post-trial motions during and at the end of the case and finds that any additional hearing would be redundant and unnecessary. Therefore, the Court



denies the Motion to Reconsider based on the facts presented at trial and the reasons set forth by the Court in the record of this case.
