MOTION FOR PERMISSION

TO ORDER

TRANSCRIPT OUT OF TIME

Pursuant to this Court's Order filed March 28, 2024, the *pro se* Appellant hereby requests the Court's "permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadlines" and provides the Court a copy of Appellant's "letter addressed to the court reporter." (see attached letter addressed to court reporter dated April 2, 2024).

The Appellant, a *pro se* litigant, has been actively involved with prosecuting this appeal. the *pro se* litigant have spoken with the assigned case analyst multiple times regarding guidance on curing the noted deficiencies and how those deficiencies, until cured, postponed the running of any other deadlines set out in the rules of appellate court procedure. Notably, the Clerk of this Court did not include as a deficiency, in her dismissal order, non-compliance with the requirements set for ordering the transcript.

The pro se Appellant understood, *buttressed by the Court's clerk staff understanding and advisement of the same*¹, that the other deadlines for perfecting an appeal became automatically postponed until the noted deficiencies were cured.

The pro se Appellant believes he is entitled to have his appeal heard on the merit which is what the spirit of the law calls for.

The Appellant feels hostility from the Court **in its threat to dismiss this case**, without such a request being made by any party and without any prejudice being shown for the *very brief delay* by caused by the *pro se* Appellant's life-circumstances in seeking to cure the noted deficiencies.

Rather than seeking to prematurely dismiss this appeal, the panel of judges assigned to hear and determine this appeal ought to be concerned with the merit of the pro se Appellant's appellate issues.

Indeed, this Court has recognized, as other courts throughout the nation have acknowledged, cases and the matters within them, brought before a court by a *pro se* litigant, are to be dealt with solicitude by court and with the inclination to resolve matters on their merit, if any, rather than disposing of those matters *without resolution* on procedural grounds.

In conclusion, the pro se Appellant will note these: (1) all deficiencies noted by the clerk have been cured: (2) the transcript has been ordered: and (3) the request for **"permission to order the transcript outside the filing deadlines"**² is made hereby.

¹ The *pro se* Appellant was told directly by the assigned case analyst that he did not have to order the transcript unless and until he cured the deficiencies.

² The *pro se* Appellant was unsuccessful at finding any rule within the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules which require a party to an appeal to request the Court's "permission to **order the transcript** outside the filing deadlines". Again, the Clerk's office informed the *pro se* appellant that the "filing deadlines" are postponed until a noted deficiency is cured. And again, the Clerk did not note, as a deficiency in her dismissal order, a failure by the *pro se* litigant to comply with the SCACR regarding the transcript because it was her own office which advised the pro se litigant not to order the transcript until the noted deficiency
