Enclosed, please find a copy of the appeal paperwork that was filed on your behalf and a letter that I received from the Court of Appeals dated April 5, 2024, I filed the trial appeal separate from the appeal for the guilty plea.

I do not believe that there are any grounds for your appeal from the guilty plea (Appellate case 2024-542) but I filed the paperwork because you asked me to do this. Therefore, you now have to provide the court with your own reasons for the appeal from the guilty plea and you must show the court that any issues for appeal were preserved for review by the appellate court. This means that any issues you want to argue on appeal must have been objected to or placed on the record during your guilty plea.

You must provide the Court of Appeals with a written statement of your appeal grounds within 20 days of the date of this letter. Any correspondence should include your case number. You must send your statement to the court at:
