



ORDER

Appellant filed a Motion for Rule to Show Cause or a Writ of Mandamus. Respondent filed a Return and Appellant filed a Reply. After careful consideration, the motion is DENIED. *See Willimon v. City of Greenville*, 243 S.C. 82, 86-87, 132 S.E.2d 169, 171 (1963) (stating the "principal function [of writ of mandamus] is to command and execute, and not to inquire and adjudicate; therefore, it is not the purpose of the writ to establish a legal right, but to enforce one which has already been established").
