Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this matter will be dismissed:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$250.00.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must provide proof of filing a copy of your notice of appeal with the clerk of the lower court.
- The argument and documents filed as part of your notice of appeal cannot be considered at this time. You must serve and file a notice of appeal substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.

- The caption of the notice of appeal must list all of the respondents. The caption cannot contain “et al.”
