Dear Counsel:

Since Petitioner has filed multiple post-conviction relief applications challenging the underlying criminal conviction, the Court, if it determines that Petitioner has failed to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 243(c), SCACR, may decide to prohibit Petitioner from filing further post-conviction relief applications, habeas corpus actions or any other actions, motions or petitions in the circuit court challenging this conviction and sentence (including a motion under Rule 29 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure) without first obtaining the permission of this Court to do so. If Petitioner believe that there is some reason(s) why such a prohibition should not be imposed on future filings by Petitioner in the circuit court, those reasons should be provided within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter.
