

ORDER

On November 13, 2023, Appellant filed her initial reply brief. On April 10, 2024, Appellant filed an amended initial reply brief. Respondent moved to strike the amended initial reply brief because it was filed without leave of court and exceeded the page limit. Appellant filed a return, explaining her amended initial reply brief "merely corrected typographical errors and references to" designated matters. Appellant further stated her willingness to "condense the document" to the page limit or file a motion to exceed the page limit. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to strike Appellant's amended initial reply brief. We also strike Appellant's initial reply brief filed on November 13, 2023, because it exceeds the page limits. *See* Rule 208(B)(5), SCACR (stating reply briefs may not exceed twenty-five pages). Within ten days of the date of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial reply brief that complies with the page limit established by Rule 208(B)(5) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
