Im truly sorry on the oversight on my behalf of not previously supplying the paperwork needed for my appeal. Attached are now the Magistrate and Common Pleas filings for the aforementioned, and in addition to that, I would like to add a couple of details in regard to my ask for an Emergency Stay.

I asked for the stay since I was NEVER served or delivered a Common Pleas court date. I have affirmed through the Common Pleas that they have no record of service, and in addition to that, its posted online of no affirmation of service through no certified mailing.

Lastly, at this very same time, and as reported to Postmaster Letha Anderson of the Conway SC USPS, my mailbox had been entered on multiple occasion by ppl other than myself "I LIVE ALONE" and on multiple occasions I had received mail from my neighbors for 2 months. Additionally, my postal delivery person had left my rural mailbox open, and dozens of pieces of mail had been ruined by the weather. On one of these occasions of my mailbox being left open, mail was found in a neighbor's lawn some 300 feet away. All of this can be confirmed through myself and the Postmaster. Multiple complaints were filed, and the police were involved.
