

ORDER

On March 15, 2024, we dismissed this appeal as interlocutory. Appellant filed a petition for rehearing, arguing the order on appeal is immediately appealable because it "addresses a novel issue of law . . . , involves the merits of the case, the ability of [Appellant] to assert legal defenses, and affects substantial rights of [Appellant]." After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
