

ORDER

Appellant filed her initial brief and designation of matter on January 10, 2024. Appellant designated "Defendant's attorney's fees" as item 1; "Plaintiff's attorney's fees" as item 2; "Connecticut Divorce Decree, August 22, 2023" as item 5; "Proof of Plaintiff's multiple residences and income sources" as item 6; "Judge Moukawsher's Court Order from" as item 7; "Motion for Contempt for refusal to pay alimony" as item 8; and "Motion for Expenses for Children" as item 9. Respondent filed a motion to strike items 5, 8, and 9, arguing these items were not presented to the lower court. Respondent also moved for clarification of items 1, 2, 6, and 7. Appellant did not file a return. After careful consideration, we grant Respondent's motion. We strike items 5, 8, and 9 from Appellant's designation of matter. We direct Appellant to serve and file a return to Respondent's motion to clarify items 1, 2, 6, and 7, within ten days of the date of this order. In the return, Appellant shall identify specifically what these items are and explain when and how the items were presented to the lower court. Respondent may file a reply within five days of receipt of Appellant's return. We will request an amended designation of matter after consideration of Appellant's return and any reply. Appellant's failure to comply will result in dismissal of this appeal.
