

ORDER

On March 20, 2024, we dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide proof of serving the record on appeal. *See* Rule 210(a), SCACR ("Within thirty (30) days after service of the last brief, the appellant shall serve a copy of the [r]ecord on [a]ppel on each party who has served a brief. Proof of service of the [r]ecord shall be immediately filed with the clerk of the appellate court."); Rule 260(a), SCACR ("Whenever it appears that an appellant . . . has failed to comply with the requirements of these Rules, the clerk shall issue an order of dismissal . . ."). Appellant filed a motion to reconsider dismissal, which we construe as a petition for rehearing. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied.
