ORDER

Petitioners seek a writ of certiorari to review the decision of the court of appeals in *Stanton v. Town of Pawleys Island*, Op. No. 2023-UP-055 (S.C. Ct. App. filed Feb. 8, 2023). Petitioners have also requested a writ of mandamus to require the court of appeals to revise and publish its decision addressing all twenty-six issues Petitioners raised to the court of appeals. Because we find the court of appeals' opinion fairly and adequately addressed all issues on appeal, we deny the petition for a writ of mandamus. See *In re Memorandum Decisions by Ct. of Appeals*, 322

S.C. 53, 55, 471 S.E.2d 456, 457 (1993) (holding the court of appeals is authorized to issue unpublished memorandum opinions in cases so long as the court sets forth each issue on appeal and provides relevant legal authority to support its decision). Further, the petition for a writ of certiorari to the court of appeals is denied.
