The Defendant pleaded guilty to Aggravated Breach of Peace on September 7, 2022 and was sentenced to five years suspended to three years probation. In addition to the terms of probation on the sentencing sheet, the following conditions are hereby ordered as terms and conditions of the Defendant's probation:

1. The Defendant will be under intensive supervision, as long as deemed appropriate by the probation agent, but not to exceed one year.
2. The Defendant is under a permanent restraining order (separate Court Order) and shall have no contact with employees or properties of the South Carolina Public Service Authority this includes but is not limited to all administrative offices and all power generating stations. This specifically includes, but is not limited to, the Pinopolis Dam, Santee Spillway, Winyah Station.
3. The Public Service authority has immediate powers to arrest Mr. Newman is he is found on or adjacent to its properties.
4. The Defendant, while under intensive supervision, is restrained from going on or about any major hydroelectric dam including but not limited to the Lake Murray and Lake Hartwell Dams.
5. The Defendant shall report to the State of North Carolina and turn himself in to authorities on his pending probation/parole violation charge. He must do this within 30 days after the resolution of his pending Berkeley County, South Carolina General Sessions charges.
6. The Defendant shall comply with Mental Health treatment and all recommendations including taking medications as prescribed.
