MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Marvin Donte Bryan with this Court on April 1, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of Brittany C. Foster v. The State with this Court on March 28, 2024. Counsel appeared for Oral Argument in the case of The State v. Richard Kenneth Galloway before the Supreme Court on March 27, 2024.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


