To Your Honor and/or to Whom it Concerns:

I spoke too soon about my captor's length of consistent absence in my prior letter to you. He returned suddenly with excuses to stay the weekend and bother me.

While I didn't get a full confession yet because I was busy trying to avoid him and take basic care of myself, it is single-party consent here, and I did audio record him threatening to assault police if they were summoned 2 days ago.

I don't believe his work schedule allows for a recurrence, but I am not sure and am rushing to complete things for you and do something different.

I stayed up most of last night trying to finish the Modified Complaint I'd planned to propose, which looks a little more like a brief to me now that I've recently seen an example of one. It's 26 pages long, and was already lengthy before I began refining it last night. It seems, to me, as though some of the content from my May 3, 2024 ex parte letter may need to work to re-amend the Motion for Enlargement of Time, and that some of my proposed Amended Complaint may need to go into the Brief itself.

I'm working hard to get something decent to you. I apologize.
