Dear Ms. Kitchings, Ms. Harrison,

This letter is sent to seek ADDITIONAL CLARIFICATION from the Clerk of Courts Office as to six issues, as noted in the following paragraphs. This requires a response from the Clerk of Court or the Deputy Clerk of Court. Please tell me how to proceed.

I. CHANGE IN CASE STATUS

- 1) The Appellant's letter of April 19, 2024, was not answered until April 24, 2024, at 2:41 p.m.
- 2) That letter stated that my case brief due date was May 9, 2024.
- 3) At 4:10 p.m. on April 24, 2024, the case status changed significantly:

The case status was changed to "Held in Abeyance." The Court of Appeals emailed a Motion from the Respondent requesting to relieve Henrietta Golding and Burr and Forman from representing the Respondent.

II. THE MARCH 20, 2024, TRANSCRIPT IS NOT FOR THIS APPEAL

- 1) Clerk Harrison's letter of April 19, 2024 stated:

"In your letter, you indicate you have not received all relevant transcripts in this case. Our records reflect the last transcript was delivered on March 20, 2024."

- 2) There is no entry on this case ACMS index for the date March 20, 2024.

- 3) On May 2 and 3, 2024, I talked with Ms. Staley about the transcript Ms. Harrison referred to in her letter.

Ms. Staley looked up the March 20, 2024, date in an online site which is titled "Case Tracking . . ." which she is able to access. Ms. Staley said that I should be able to access that site but that she could not transport to me a link for it or a copy of what is on this site. I have tried unsuccessfully for several days to find it. **PLEASE SEND A LINK TO ME OR A COPY OF THE CONTENTS OF THAT SITE.**

- 4) The March 20, 2024, transcript entry is for a transcript produced by Natalie Dahl for a Motion Hearing before Horry County Judge Hyman heard on February 21, 2024. This transcript is NOT related to this appeal at this time. The motion date took place one month after I filed the second appeal, January 31, 2024, on Judge Debra R. McCaslin.

III. THE SECOND TRANSCRIPT - BY COURT REPORTER JULIE KEVISH - IS STILL INCOMPLETE

- 1) I have not received a complete transcript from Court Reporter Julie Kevish required for the Appeal on the Orders of Judge Debra R. McCaslin. The Motions Hearing took place on May 23, 2023.

- 2) The entry of March 19, 2024, on the ACMS refers to the transcript(s) by Julie Kevish.

Please read this email which is on the ACMS case record. This is an email to Julie Kevish giving her NOTICE NOT to destroy the audio or digital recordings and NOT TO DESTROY THE TRANSCRIPTS OF THE HEARING OF APRIL 24, 2023, BEFORE JUDGE DEBRA R. MMCCASLIN ON CASE NO. 2020-CP-260-5267, IN THE FIFTEENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT.

- 3) THIS EMAIL WAS SENT TO HER BECAUSE I HAVE NOT RECEIVED THE ENTIRE TRANSCRIPT! NOR HAVE I RECEIVED COPIES OF HER COMMUNICATIONS TO THE COURT IN WHICH SHE SOUGHT THE PROTECTION OF THE COURT WHEN I CHALLENGED HER INCOMPLETE TRANSCRIPT. THIS IS A VIOLATION OF COURT REPORTER RULES.

- 4) I HAVE ONLY RECEIVED ONE COPY OF A PARTIAL TRANSCRIPT ON THIS HEARING, DESPITE NUMEROUS NUMEROUS ATTEMPTS TO GET THE ENTIRE TRANSCRIPT.

PLEASE TAKE THE ACTIONS NECESSARY TO HAVE JULIE KEVISH COMPLETE THIS TRANSCRIPT.

IV. INSTRUCTIONS REQUESTED REGARDING BRIEF DUE DATE

- 1) On May 2, 2024, and May 3, 2024, I talked with Ms. Staley about how the case status change

impacts the brief due date. She consulted with the Clerk of Court and informed me that the brief due date is on hold while the case is held in abeyance.

THIS IS TO REQUEST THAT A CLERK OF THE COURT PLEASE WRITE A LETTER TO ME CONFIRMING THIS FACT AND PROVIDE DIRECTION ON WHEN AND HOW TO PROCEED.

V. DO I NEED TO SUBMIT A MOTION FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO COMPLETE THE BRIEF?

Two factors are impacting the brief due date at this time:

- 1) The case is held in abeyance, and
- 2) The Second Transcript is still incomplete.

VI. THIS IS TO NOTIFY THE COURT THAT I AM REQUESTING AN ENLARGEMENT OF TIME TO COMPLETE THE BRIEF, IF AN ENLARGEMENT OF TIME IS REQUIRED. PLEASE PROVIDE THE NECESSARY INSTRUCTIONS.

PLEASE SEE THE ACMS DOCUMENTS RECORDED ON MARCH 24, MARCH 19, AND MARCH 9, 2024, WHICH ARE REFERRED TO IN THIS LETTER.
