MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Kevin Mark Willson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from May 8, 2024 until June 7, 2024 in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. 

Counsel filed the Return to Motion to Remand in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Jeremiah James Pough with the Court of Appeals on March 7, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. On May 1, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through May 31, 2024.
