



ORDER


After careful consideration, Appellant's pro se motion filed April 26, 2024, is granted in part and denied in part. Appellant's request to substitute the Respondents "sued in their official capacity for persons now holding those offices" is granted. *See* Rule 265(d), SCACR ("If a public officer in his official capacity is a party to an action pending in an appellate court and during its pendency he ceases to hold office, his successor in office shall be automatically substituted as a party. . . . An order of substitution may be entered at any time upon the suggestion of the substituted party or any other party . . ."). The caption is amended as set forth in this order.

Appellant's request to amend the statement of issues on appeal and Appellant's request to supplement the record on appeal are denied.
