
As of this above referenced date, I have not received an order granting the State leave upon their motion.



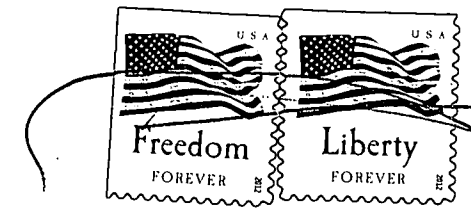

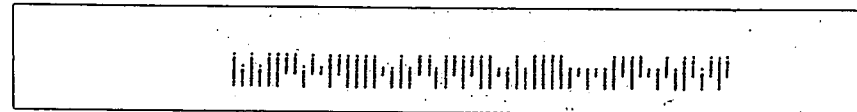
