* Destroying!


Appellant has long requested the Transcript





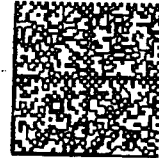
