ORDER

On March 20, 2024, Appellant moved this court for an order directing Respondent Wells Fargo & Company, Inc. (Wells Fargo) to preserve evidence in its possession. Wells Fargo filed a return, representing that it had "issued a litigation hold and will continue to preserve all available evidence in accordance with its obligations to do so" and opposing any request to supplement the record with information not presented to the lower court. Appellant filed a reply, stating the evidence "should be considered." Based upon Wells Fargo's representations that it has issued a litigation hold and will continue to preserve all evidence in accordance with its obligations to do so, we deny the motion to preserve evidence. To the extent Appellant seeks to supplement the record with information not presented to the lower court, we deny the motion. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR (explaining "[t]he [r]ecord shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal").
