**MOTION TO AMEND RECORD ON APPEAL
AND TO RE-SET FILING DEADLINE**

Petitioner John Doe respectfully moves for leave to amend the Record on Appeal, for the following reasons:

1. As filed in the Court of Appeals, the Record on Appeal is more than 1,700 pages in length.
