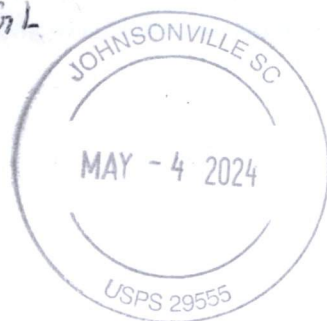

That's why I was suing South Carolina Unemployment and Workforce for my benefits they denied me during COVID-19 and that's why I was suing SEFA Transportation for lost wages and wrongful termination.
