

ORDER

On February 2, 2024, we dismissed this appeal as interlocutory. Appellant filed a petition for rehearing, arguing the administrative law court's order remanding his case was final. After careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, the petition for rehearing is denied. *See Torrence v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 433 S.C. 224, 228, 857 S.E.2d 549, 550–51 (2021) (allowing the appeal to proceed but explaining "the better approach when facing a remand is to conclude the remand before pursuing an appeal").
