

ORDER

This appeal arises out of a probation revocation hearing on December 15, 2023. The notice of appeal was served on May 2, 2024. The appeal is dismissed for the failure to timely serve the notice of appeal. *See* Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR ("After a plea or trial resulting in conviction or a proceeding resulting in revocation of probation, a notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within ten (10) days after the sentence is imposed."); *State v. Devore*, 416 S.C. 115, 119, 784 S.E.2d 690, 692 (Ct. App. 2016) ("[I]n the absence of a timely served notice of appeal, this court has no jurisdiction."). Based on the failure to timely serve the notice of appeal, we decline to take action on the appellant's motion for appointment of counsel. The remittitur will be sent pursuant to Rule 221(b), SCACR.
