APPELLANT'S WRITTEN OBJECTIONS

COMES NOW Appellant Kevin E. Herrdott in pro se, in necessity, moves this Honorable Court for a(n) Order granting in favor of Appellant's written objections to Final Judgment order filed April 30, 2024.
