APPELLANT’S MOTION TO FILE AND SERVE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF
MATTER TO BE INCLUDED IN RECORD ON APPEAL OUT OF TIME AND FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME

Appellant respectfully moves this Court pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for an Order extending the deadline for Appellant to file and serve its Initial Brief and Designation of Matter by thirty (30) days.
