Notice of Appeal

Christopher Kennan appeals the order of denial of "plaintiff's petition for Rehearing" by order of his Honour named above (which was appealing that court's earlier decision to dismiss the Complaint due to a timely proof of service not being provided to Defendant ~~I~~ who have not yet been served any complaint nor summons), and dated May 14, 2024.

The original appeal concerns the Clarendon County Court of Common Pleas' refusal to allow pro se, indigent, plaintiff to proceed in forma pauperis, and therefore ~~to be~~ ^{refused him to} be allowed to file his complaint with that court. No summonses nor complaint were served to any defendant ~~in~~ named in this case. The only case number assigned to this case was from this Supreme Court. Plaintiff is arguing that since his complaint concerns fundamental South Carolina and United States Constitutional rights violations, he should be allowed to proceed in forma pauperis as a matter of law, and that there is a dispute over whether or not proof of service of an appeal is required in this case in which no defendant was served any summons nor complaint (and therefore not yet made party to this suit. Again this is because Clarendon County Court of Common Pleas' refusal to approve pro se, indigent, plaintiff in forma pauperis application and motion to reconsider, and its subsequent refusal to file this complaint without prepayment of fees).

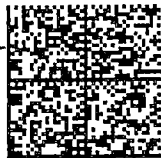
