MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR APPELLANT TO
ORDER TRIAL TRANSCRIPT

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, appellant Kenneth Henry Eastwood moves for permission to order the hearing transcript in this matter outside of the filing deadlines set by Rule 207 of the SCACR. This is the first request for an extension filed by Appellant.
