Dear Ms. Allen:

In the above referenced matter, two appeals have been filed. First, Briefs regarding the merits of the case or the compensability of Mr. Jeter's claim have been filed by counsel for the Appellant and counsel for the Respondent. (Appellate Case No.: 2013-00764).

With regard to the second appeal, which involves a coverage issue, only the Initial Brief of Hartford Insurance Company of the Midwest has been filed. (Appellate Case No.: 2013-00599). ULLICO has not yet filed a Brief due to it being declared insolvent and the case being transferred to the South Carolina Guaranty Association Fund. Because ULLICO Insurance Company sought bankruptcy protection, the statute regarding to the Guaranty Fund stayed all proceedings for ninety (90) days or until August 27, 2013. Since the merits and coverage issues are closely intertwined, I am writing to ascertain whether the Record on Appeal and Final Briefs should be submitted in accordance with the Court's timeline or upon the filing and perfection of these documents which have been stayed by ULLICO's insolvency and the involvement of the South Carolina Guaranty Fund.

Please advise of your decision and preference as to whether you would prefer to receive the Record on Appeal and Final Briefs on the merits issue at this juncture or


