NOW COMES Petitioner, Atlas Turner, Inc., by and through their undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, as well as the Court's order of July 16, 2014, regarding Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to Review a Decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals, and hereby move for an extension of ten (10) days' time to file/serve their petition to this Court for issuance of a writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals to review its decision in this matter.

Pursuant to Rule 242(c), SCACR, the present deadline for the petition for writ of certiorari is May 30, 2024. Due to other time commitments, both work- and non-work-related, the undersigned counsel for Petitioner requests ten (10) additional days, beyond May 30, 2024, to prepare Petitioner's petition seeking this Court's review of the Court of Appeals' decision via writ of certiorari, and the undersigned submits there is good cause to allow the requested dispensation: It is in furtherance of the interests of justice; it will not work any undue prejudice upon any other party; and it is consistent with the extension protocol established by the Court's aforementioned order of July 16, 2014.
