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## ORDER


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In 1990, petitioner was convicted and sentenced for murder and possession of a firearm or knife during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime. *State v. Patterson*, 1990-GS-46-002657. On direct appeal, these convictions and sentences were affirmed by the South Carolina Court of Appeals. *State v. Patterson*, Op. No. 1992-MO-89 (S.C. Ct. App. filed April 24, 1992).




In the current case, petitioner has filed a notice of appeal from the denial of his sixth application for post-conviction relief regarding the above convictions. The notice of appeal is hereby dismissed based on petitioner's failure to provide an adequate explanation under Rule 243(c), SCACR.

Further, this Court hereby prohibits petitioner from filing a post-conviction relief application, a habeas corpus action, a motion under Rule 29 of the South Carolina Rules of Criminal Procedure, or other action or motion challenging his 1990 convictions and/or sentences in the circuit court without first obtaining permission to do so from this Court.

The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221, SCACR.
