Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Raymond Martinez with the Court of Appeals on April 17, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Douglas Young v. The State with this Court on April 3, 2024. On March 12, 2024, Counsel presented oral argument in the case of Victor D. Smith v. The State before the Court of Appeals. Counsel filed the Brief of Appellant in the case of The State v. John A. Welch with the Court of Appeals on March 5, 2024. Counsel filed the Motion for Stay of Execution and Appointment of Post-Conviction Relief Judge in the case of The State v. Timothy Ray Jones, Jr. with this Court on March 5, 2024. Counsel was a presenter at the S.C. Bar Criminal Practice CLE on February 23, 2024, in Columbia, South Carolina. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.




