Additionally, your request for the transcript must be made with the court reporter. You must show that you have made payment arrangements, notify the Court Administration and opposing counsel.

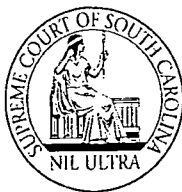



Dear Mr. Flowers:

Your letter to Court Administration dated January 25, 2011, was forwarded to me for response. In your letter you are asking for a transcript to be transcribed by court reporter, Krystal J. Smith. You are asserting that you are indigent and request that your Cooper account be debited as the funds become available. Unfortunately, we are unable to proceed in that fashion.

Please be advised that the procedure is for you to write to the court reporter and request the transcript.
