
## ORDER


This appeal was dismissed on January 30, 2024, after Appellants failed to provide a proof of service for the notice of appeal. The same day, Appellants filed a proof of service showing the notice of appeal was served on Respondents on January 16, 2024; we construe this filing as a petition to rehear the dismissal. However, because Appellants received written notice of entry of the order on appeal on November 21, 2023, the proof of service is untimely. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR (providing the notice of appeal must be served on all respondents within thirty days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order); *Mears v. Mears*, 287 S.C. 168, 169, 337 S.E.2d 206, 207 (1985) ("Service of the notice of intent to appeal is a jurisdictional requirement, and this Court has no authority to extend or expand the time in which the notice of intent to appeal must be served."). Accordingly, there is no basis for granting a rehearing and the petition is denied.
